Nagpur is a city located in the state of Maharashtra, India that seamlessly blends its rich history and cultural heritage with modern development and natural beauty. It offers a range of experiences for visitors, from exploring historical landmarks to enjoying local cuisine and experiencing the vibrant city life.

Nagpur is also surrounded by several wildlife parks and sanctuaries that offer opportunities to witness diverse flora and fauna.

**Deekshabhoomi:** It is a sacred Buddhist monument and the largest stupa in Asia. Sitabuldi Fort: Built during the British era, Sitabuldi Fort offers panoramic views of the city. It now serves as the headquarters of the Indian Army's 118<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion.

**Zero Mile Stone:** Nagpur is often considered as the geographical center of India, and the Zero Mile Stone monument marks this significance. It is a landmark and a popular spot for tourists to take pictures.

**Pench National Park:** Located approximately 90 kilometers from Nagpur, Pench National Park is famous for its rich biodiversity and is home to tigers, leopards, sloth bears, Indian gaur, and various species of deer. It is known for its scenic beauty and has been the inspiration for Rudyard Kipling's famous novel "The Jungle Book."

**Tadoba Andhari Tiger Reserve:** Situated around 140 kilometers from Nagpur, Tadoba Andhari Tiger Reserve is one of the largest and oldest national parks in Maharashtra. It is known for its significant tiger population and provides excellent tiger sighting opportunities. The reserve is also home to other wildlife species such as leopards, sloth bears, wild dogs, and numerous bird species.

Ramtek: Ramtek is a historical town known for its temple of Rama. Legend has it that Rama rested here during his exile, giving the place its name. The current temple was constructed in the 18th century by Raghuji Bhonsale, the Maratha ruler of Nagpur, after his triumph over the Deogarh fort in Chindwara. The area was also close to the ashram of the Hindu sage Agastya, according to Hindu mythology.

**Khindsi:** Khindsi Lake, located just 5 km from Ramtek, is a stunning lake surrounded by lush forests. It offers a variety of water sports, including motor boats, pedal boats, rowing boats, and water scooters, making it a perfect destination to admire the scenic beauty while enjoying the activities.

**Swaminarayan temple:** On October 7, 2013, India inaugurated its 750th Swaminarayan temple in Wathoda near the Middle Ring Road. The temple, the largest among 1,000+ temples established by Swaminarayan Sanstha worldwide, was inaugurated with Vedic chants and rituals after two days of preparation.

Gorewada International Zoo: Balasaheb Thackeray Gorewada International Zoological Park in Nagpur, Maharashtra, India, is named in honor of the late Marathi leader. It is one of the largest captive Zoo Safaris in India, covering over 1914 hectares of land adjacent to Gorewada Lake. The park features Tribal Art, Wildlife Rescue Center, Indian Safari, African Safari, Interpretation Center, Trail of Senses, and Night Safari.

**Anandwan (Forest of Happiness):** Located 105km from Nagpur, founded by the internationally known human rights activist, the late Baba Amte, is a perfect example of pioneering social work in rehabilitation of leprosy affected families.

**Hemalkasa:** Situated approx 320km from Nagpur, is known for Lok Biradari Prakalp - started by renowned social worker Baba Amte, for integrated development of Madia Gond tribe.

**Pavnar ashram (69km from Nagpur):** Founded and developed by Acharya Vinoba Bhave in 1939, for practising spirituality, education of girls and women.

**Sewagram (75 km from Nagpur):** Village of service – Sevagram ashram remained the abode of Mahatma Gandhi from 1936 till his death. The museum, the historical details and the serene ambience will touch every visitor.
